# Youth Retreat Rules

The Retreat Director, while under the authority of the eldership of the Anchorage Church of Christ, is, during Youth Retreat, the final authority on all matters pertaining to policy and rules. He will be responsible for determining whether a camper will be returned home due to illness, safety infractions, or failure to obey rules.

- \* At a minimum, parents and/or guardians and the elders of the Anchorage Church of Christ will be notified if any camper breaks the law, and the camper will immediately be sent home.
- \* Chaperones shall be at least 21 years old.
- \* Campers must submit a registration form signed by parent or legal guardian, and camper. No camper will be allowed to proceed to camp without this form completed and signed.
- \* Individuals with special needs may attend camp if the camp staff is able to attend to those needs within their normal camp duties. The determination of whether or not the camp staff is capable of meeting those needs is the responsibility of the Youth Retreat Director.
- \* Cabin campfires must be supervised at all times and extinguished properly before abandoning them.
- \* Hiking on roads or trails will be done as a group of three or more with an adult present.
- \* Every individual will wear a life jacket while participating in any boating activity. Swimming, boating, or any other water activity is allowed only during supervised periods.
- \* Dress shall be modest at all times, with no inappropriate words or images.
- \* Campers must remain with a supervised group at all times.

## Off Limits for Campers

- \* Any area of the lake from which the "Main Dock" cannot be seen.
- \* The shores of property the camp does not own except with express permission of the property owner obtained by the director.
- \* Public land with the exception of supervised hikes, and canoe trips.

## Not Allowed

- \* Guns, fireworks, knives, tobacco products, alcohol, illegal drugs
- \* Electronic devices: You may bring your cell phone. However, It is only to be used for your Bible and to take photos. Anyone caught using them for any other reason will have their phone taken away for the duration of the retreat. You may also bring stand-alone cameras. All other electronic devices are prohibited.
- \* Littering of the campgrounds
- \* Food and drinks in the cabins
- \* Any display of affection beyond holding hands
- \* Coming to camp without prior approval from the Youth Retreat Director, including parents or other visitors.

## Dress Code

We are trying to create an environment free of distractions so that we can concentrate on GOD. Dress should be representative of who we are as Christians.

- Sleeves, please! NO Spaghetti strap tops, halter-tops, tube tops, tank tops, etc.
- Necklines should be modest. NO low cut tops (avoid visual cleavage)
- NO sagging! (Nobody wants to see your underwear)
- NO shorts, skirts, or cut-offs can be above the knee. (They must be to the knee).
- Don't advertise for the wrong guys! NO clothing promoting tobacco, alcohol, cigarettes, sex, questionable sayings, slogans, etc.
- Yikes! NO bare midriffs- shirts should be long enough that no skin is visible.
- NO tight clothing! Garment should not be so tight as to reveal the outline of under garments or body parts.
- Dress shall be modest at all times. If a chaperone deems clothing inappropriate, you must change. If you do not have a change of clothes, one will be provided for you.
